### Guidelines for Fair Use of e-Resources

The library, NIPER Raebareil provides access to various electronic resources to its authorised users, such as faculty members, scientists, researchers, students, staffs etc. Use of each resources being made available to the NIPER Raebareli Community is governed by the terms and conditions spelt out in electronic resource license agreements. Copyright law in addition to individual license agreements also governs the use of e-Resources. Licenses vary from publisher to publisher; however, the general principles are as follows:

1. Electronic resources such as e-journals, e-databases, e-books etc. made available by the Library, NIPER Raebareli are for academic use.
2. These resources can be searched, browsed and material may be downloaded and printed as a single copy of articles, as is done in the case of printed library material. Downloading or printing of a complete book or an entire issue or a volume of one or more journals, or a large portions of other e-resources (called systematic downloading) is strictly prohibited. Please be aware that systematic downloading may cause the publisher to block to the entire community of users @ NIPER Raebareli from accessing these resources.
